Generalized Feline Plan for Optimum Health

Kitten (0-12 months)

6 weeks: comprehensive physical exam, fecal exam, first kitten vaccination, information on relevant issues specific to the kitten presented, discussion of behavior, etc., send home kitten kit

9 weeks: comprehensive physical exam, second fecal exam if any parasites found at first exam, second kitten vaccination, any questions or concerns

12 weeks: comprehensive physical exam, third kitten vaccination, rabies vaccination, any questions or concerns

15 weeks: comprehensive physical exam, fourth kitten vaccination, any questions or concerns

4-6 months: surgical sterilization including preanesthetic bloodwork, IV fluids, pain management, FIV / FeLV test if contact with outdoor cat

Adult Cat (1-10 years)

Annual comprehensive exam, annual heartworm test, annual fecal exam, dietary counseling if needed, any questions or concerns

Recommend healthy baseline bloodwork (including FIV / FeLV test if contact with outdoor cat) at least every 24-36 months during the adult life stage

Senior Cat (11+ years)

Every 6 months: comprehensive exam, geriatric bloodwork and thyroid hormone, dietary and pain counseling if needed

Every 12 months: fecal exam, FIV / FeLV test if outdoor cat or contact with outdoor cats, targeted bloodwork as needed

This is a generalized plan for lifelong wellness to be tailored to each individual pet and client to meet their needs. Please be an active participant in the wellness of your pet.

If at any time your cat is diagnosed with a chronic condition, more information on that specific disease process will be provided at that time.
